In commemoration of the centenary for the ending of World War One the Launceston WW1 100 group present the, "defining record of the 94 fallen soldier's from their home town of Launceston and the fallen stories of surrounding parishes".

About the Exhibition.

The exhibition includes details of the battles that they fought in. The story of the home front will also be told, including how the town and district helped home Belgium refugee's and how the Women's Land Army can trace it's beginnings to the Launceston Women's Suffrage Society.

The exhibition opens Friday 9th November at Central Methodist Church at 7.30 pm with a presentation of the 'Launceston Fallen Book' and exhibition by Roger Pyke followed by a question and answer session. The exhibition runs to Sunday 11th November with a Soup and Lunch available at Central, small cost, following the remembrance service.
